North East London ICB (Integrated Care Board), has recently announced a signifcant changed to funding which means that the majority of the costs associated with us sending our patients text messages are now being passed on to the GP Practices.

For Stratford Health Centre and The Forest Practice this is forecast to be nearly £20,000 of additional cost and this is simply not sustainable.

As a result, our default method of communication will be via the NHS APP as this is a free service

We recommended that all patients with a smartphone use this APP and ensure notifications are enabled so that our updates are successfully received.



'Quad-demic' warning as NHS faces strain due to four winter illnesses ·

NHS experts have issued a warning over a 'quad-demic' of four winter illnesses which could put major strain on the health service. These are flu, covid, norovirus and RSV (respiratory syncytial virus)

Vaccination programmes are available for eligible patients within Primary Care for flu, covid and RSV and we recommend getting vaccinated.

Flu is one of the most common winter illnesses and can include:

- > a sudden high temperature
- an aching body
- feeling tired or exhausted
- > a dry cough
- a sore throat
- > a headache
- difficulty sleeping
- loss of appetite
- diarrhoea or tummy pain
- feeling sick and being sick

Check if you are eligible for a free flu jab

- ✓ Pregnant women
- ✓ All Children aged 2 or 3 on 31st August 2024
- ✓ All children in clinical risk groups aged from 6 months to 18 years
- ✓ Patients aged 65 years and over
- ✓ Those aged 18 years to 65 years in clinical risk groups
- ✓ Those in long stay residential care homes
- ✓ Carers
- √ Immunocompromised individuals
- ✓ Frontline healthcare workers


